This week in 3E... We read a Cherokee legend titled *Yonder Mountain.* We used this story to compare and contrast the characters and events. In grammar, we reviewed quotations, homophones and homographs. We used our Chromebooks this week to conduct research about the different animal groups (mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, amphibians). Students took notes and then used their findings to write a comparative paragraph on two animal groups of their choice. We started a new unit in math on Measurement. We focused on cm, m, km, g, and kg this week. In Science, we discussed why climate varies and how seasons differ from place to place. We will wrap up our unit on weather next week and then have a short assessment. Completed worksheets, textbook and study guide will come home prior to the test so students can prepare.
