This week in 3E...

We read a biography titled *Young Thomas Edison*. We practiced identifying the main idea and supporting details of a text and worked on summary writing. Graded lesson 9 & 10 tests will be sent home on Monday. Please sign and return. Next week students will get a chance to do some research of their own on a famous inventor! They will then create an informational brochure and share what they learned with the class. *There will be NO reading or spelling test next week due to Scantron testing.

We are currently working on division in math. This week, students practiced using related multiplication facts to help them solve division problems. Next week we will focus on dividing with remainders. It is imperative that students continue to practice their basic multiplication facts at home. They are encouraged to take advantage of the Study Island and Xtra Math websites. Knowing basic facts and strategies to answer math questions correctly, and quickly is very important!

At this time students may begin looking for a book. Please use the Lexile site listed on the golden sheet to help find an appropriate book. Once students have selected a book they'd like to read, they need to fill out the title and author (on half sheet) and bring this along with their book to school for approval by Dec. 18th! If your child needs assistance finding a book at their level, please let me know! **The Lexile number** that is listed on the golden sheet is based off your child's FALL Scantron test score. We will be taking the winter Scantron test next week. If your child's Lexile number changes, I will be sure to send home their updated Lexile number next week once we have finished the reading portion of the Scantron test.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in the Six Flags - Great America Read to Succeed Club! An informational letter and record keeping sheets will be sent home 12/20. This reading must be in addition to all other assigned reading.

Though the holidays may be busy, we do encourage kids to read, get on StudyIsland and practice their math facts. An extra credit multiplication packet will be sent home with the kids to work on over the winter break. This is optional.
